


## Mounting Precautions (For SHARP dealers and service engineers)


### When used by mounting on the wall

- Install on a vertical wall having enough strength that is free from vibrations.
- · Do not apply any other load on the wall mount bracket.
- · Do not use other than this product.
- The wall mount bracket anchors (supplied) are for concrete walls. They cannot be used for other materials.
- · Depending on the wall, the wall mount bracket screws (supplied) and wall mount bracket anchors (supplied) may not be available. The work must be performed by an authorized SHARP dealer. Our company will bear no responsibility for accidents or injuries caused by improper mounting or mishandling.
- 1. Fix the A wall mount bracket (supplied) on the wall with wall mount bracket screws (supplied) (x3).
  - · If necessary, use the wall mount bracket anchors (supplied).
- 2. Fix this product and the B wall mount bracket (supplied) with the camera screw (supplied).
- 3. Suspend the B wall mount bracket (supplied) to the A wall mount bracket (supplied).



A wall mount bracket





### **Remote Control Unit**

Operate the remote control unit while facing the front of this product.



Mic button
 Used to switch the mic to ON/OFF.

2. Auto framing button

Used to switch the auto framing function to ON/OFF.

Used to move the display range of the camera after zooming the camera.

5. Call button

Answer the communication.\*

6. End Call button

Hang up communication.\*

7. Volume button

Used to adjust the speaker volume.

8. Zoom button

Used to zoom-in or zoom-out the camera display.

- 9. Preset (1/2) button
- Used to change the display to the preset magnification rate or display position during camera display. This button cannot be used if the auto framing function is ON
- To register the preset, adjust the camera display to the state that you want to register, and then press and hold preset "1" or "2" for 2 seconds or longer.

### Preparing the remote control unit

1. Pull the cover off.



2. Put in the lithium battery (CR2032) with their plus (+) and minus (-) sides oriented correctly.



3. Close the cover.


