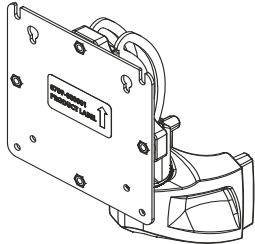

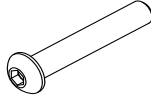

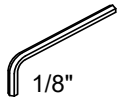

INTRODUCTION

NOTE: Follow all topics in their order of appearance.

MOUNTING POLE TO SURFACE

NOTE: The MM-P-100 may be mounted to a surface with a maximum thickness of 1.65 in. (41.9mm). (See Figure A)

NOTE: The MM-P-100 may be mounted to a surface with a mounting hole size ranging from 0.4 to 1.0 in. (10.2 to 25.4mm). Alternatively, it may be mounted using a larger grommet hole (inner grommet cover may need to be removed) where cables can be routed into the hole behind the pole. (See Figure A)

1. Insert 3/8-16 x 3" hex head screw (F) through one plate (A), up through the mounting surface, through the second plate (A) and tighten into the threaded hole in the bottom of the 14" pole (G). (See Figure A)

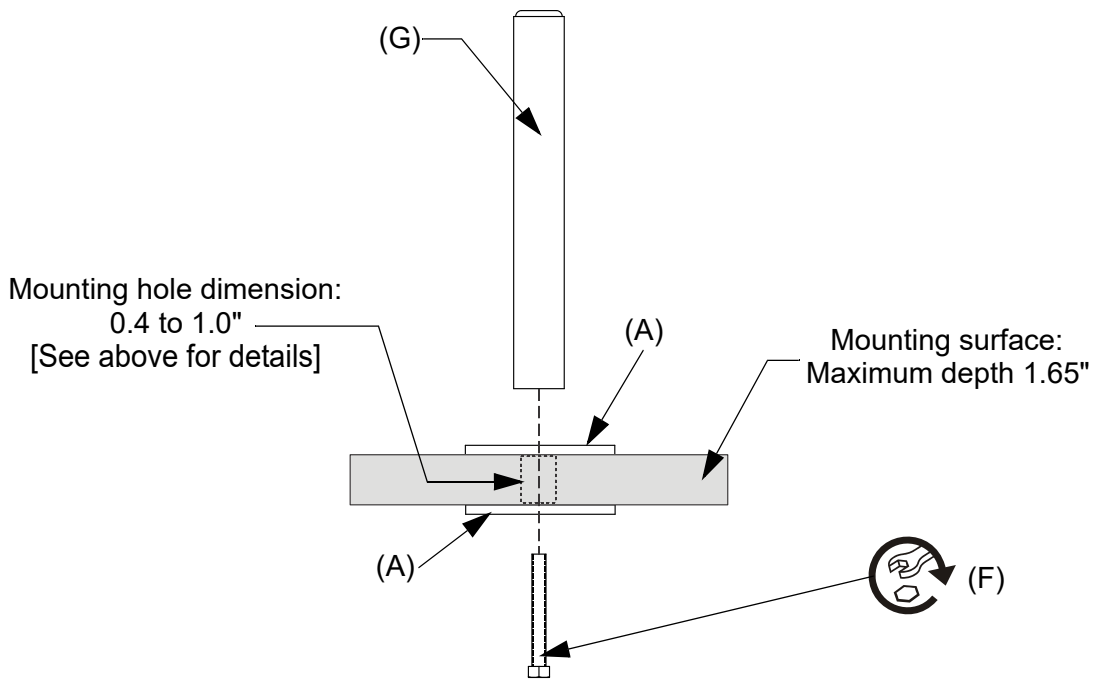

CONNECTING DISPLAY MOUNT ASSEMBLY TO POLE

1. Determine approximate location for mount keeping in mind display size, extension, height adjustment requirements.
2. Place display assembly (D) against pole (G) with pole clamp (B) on opposite side of pole. (See Figure B)
3. Using 5/32" hex key (J) and four 1/4-20 x 1-1/2" button head cap screws (E), loosely attach display assembly to pole clamp (B). (See Figure B)
4. Position mount at desired height and orientation.
5. Equally tighten screws against display assembly and the pole clamp.

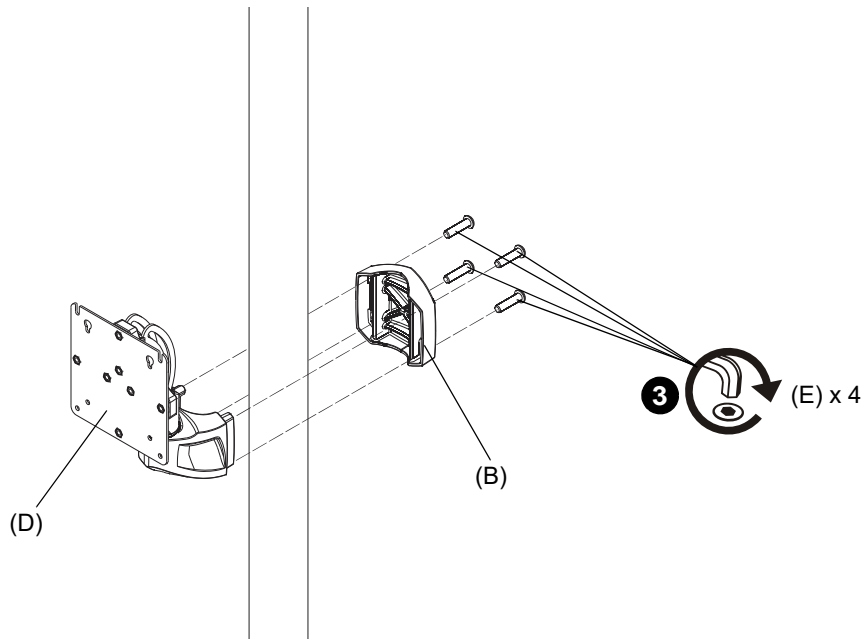

DISPLAY INSTALLATION

1. Remove quick release faceplate from mount by pulling quick release lever and sliding faceplate off mount.
2. Carefully place display face down on protective surface.
(See Figure C)

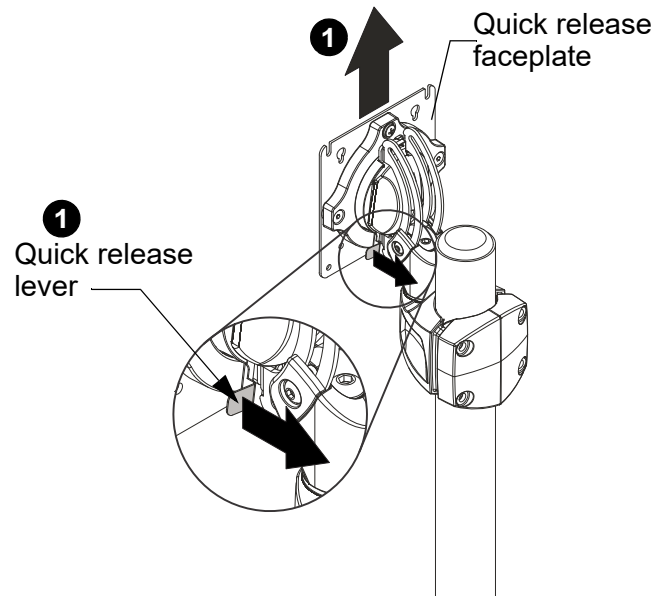

3. Connect faceplate to display.

For flush mounting hole installation:

- Using Phillips screwdriver, carefully install four M4x10mm screws (M) through corresponding holes on faceplate and into the mounting holes on the display. (See Figure D)

For recessed mounting hole installation:

- Place four spacers (Q) on top of mounting holes on back of display. (See Figure E)
- Using Phillips screwdriver, carefully install four M4x20mm screws (N) through corresponding holes on faceplate, spacers (Q) and into the mounting holes on the display. (See Figure E)

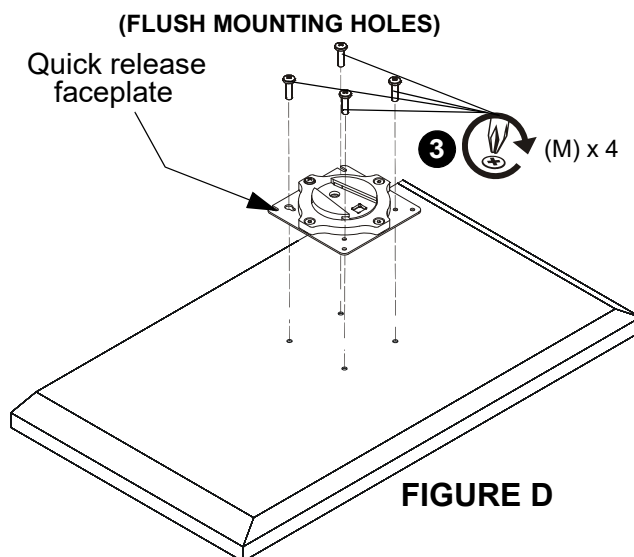

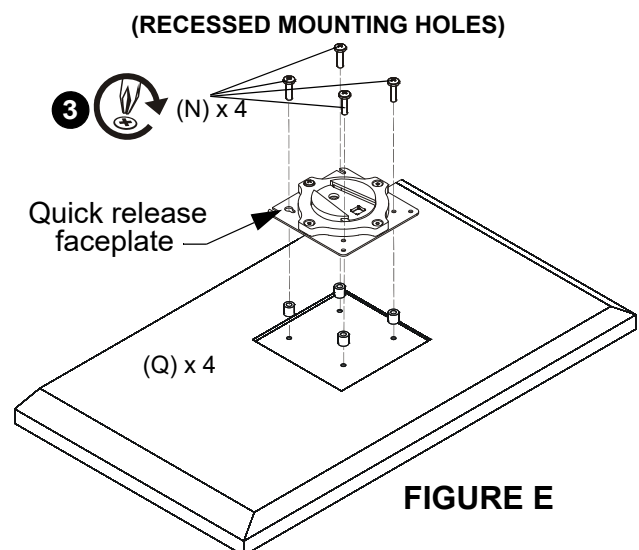

4. Position display with faceplate attached above mount.
5. Slide faceplate onto mounting head until quick release tab clicks into place. (See Figure F)
6. Run cables down the pole and cover with the cable sheath (C).

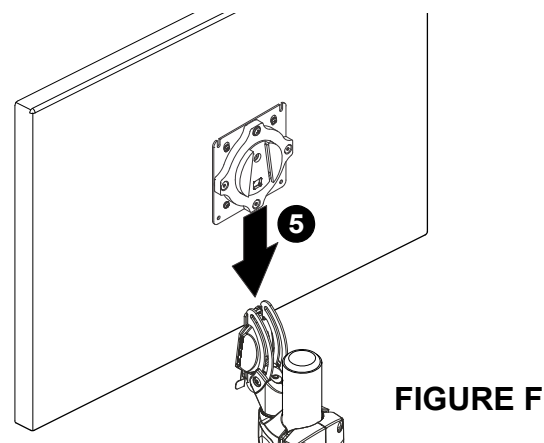

ADJUSTMENTS

Pitch Adjustment

1. Adjust pitch to desired tilt position. (See Figure G)
2. Adjust pitch tension screw to change the adjustment tension. (See Figure G)

Pivot Adjustment

3. Adjust pivot position as desired. (See Figure G)
4. Use 3/16" hex key (K) to adjust pivot point tension screws to change pivot adjustment tension. (See Figure G)
5. The monitor may be adjusted 90 degrees in either direction in order to provide a portrait view of the monitor. (See Figure G)
6. Use 3/16" hex key (K) to adjust rotational adjustment screw to adjust rotational tension. (See Figure G)

Rotational Adjustment

NOTE: (Optional) Rotational adjustment may be locked by installing one 10-32 x 3/8" button head screw (P) as the rotational locking screw into back of faceplate. (See Figure H)

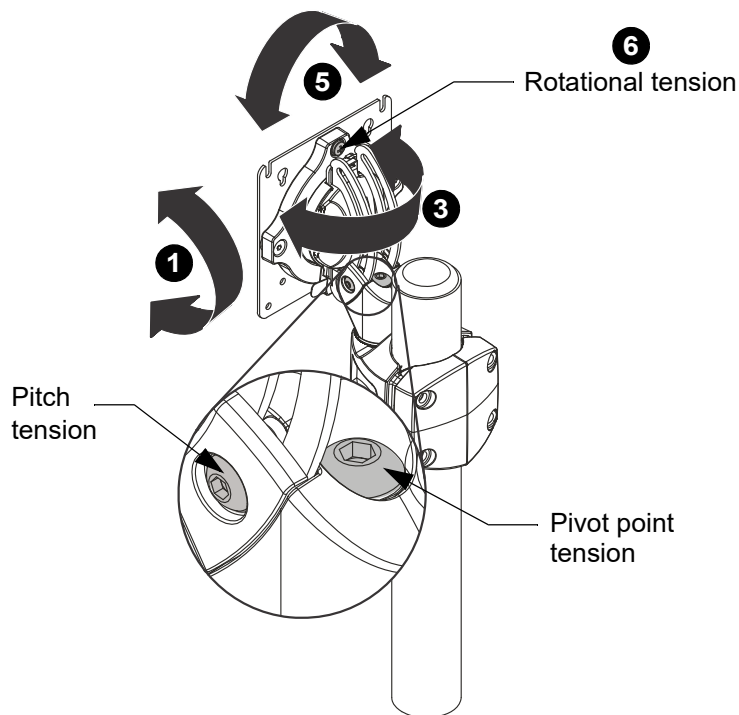

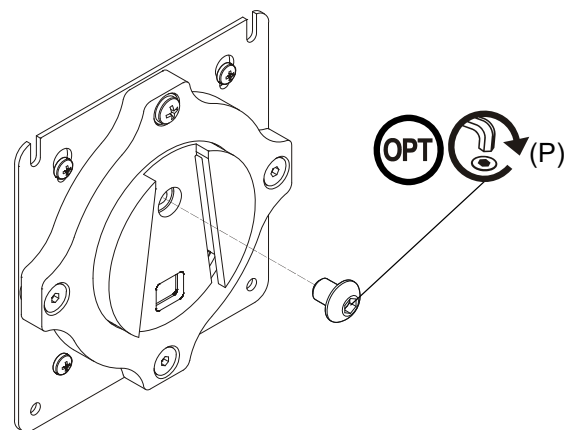

Display Removal

⚠ WARNING: Only remove display from mount when the display can be lifted up from the mount! DO NOT remove display unless the display is in the upright position! (See Figure I)

1. Make sure display is in the upright position.
2. Remove quick release faceplate from mount by pulling quick release lever and sliding faceplate up and off the mount. (See Figure I)

(OPTIONAL) Display Removal Security Screw

3. In order to prevent display from being easily removed from mount using the quick release lever, install M4x4mm Phillips screw (L) into lower hole on back of faceplate. (See Figure J)

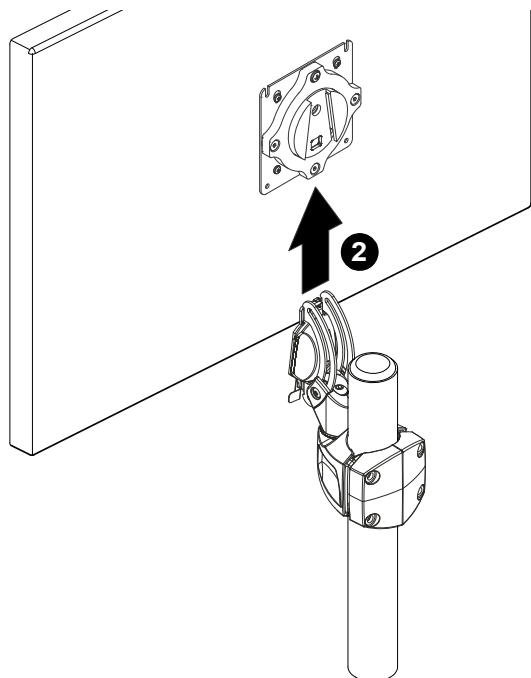

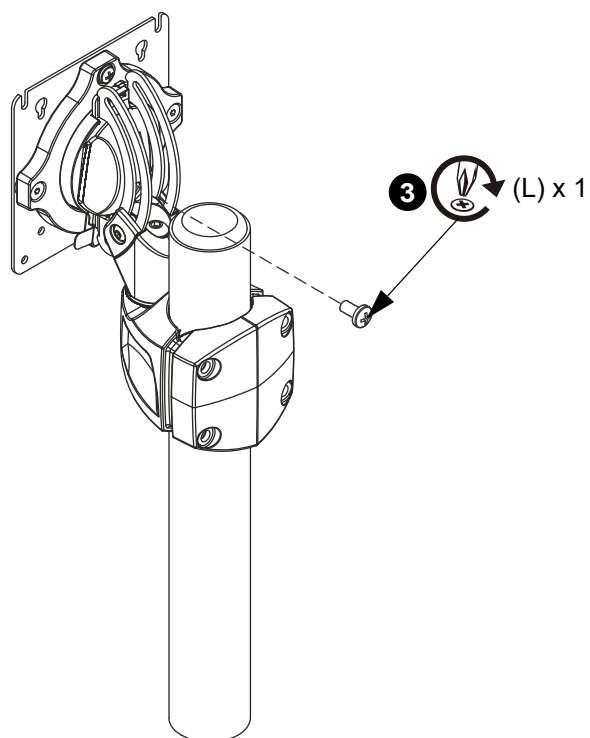
