

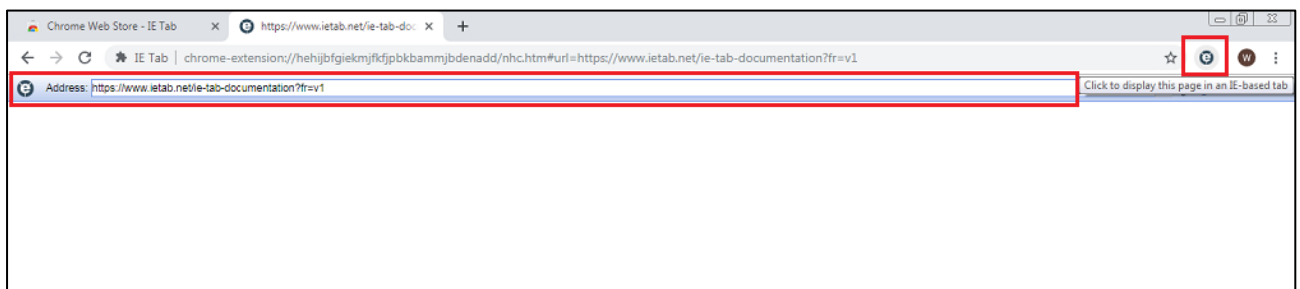
How can I view my WBOX device using Chrome or Firefox browser on my Windows PC?

Disclaimer:

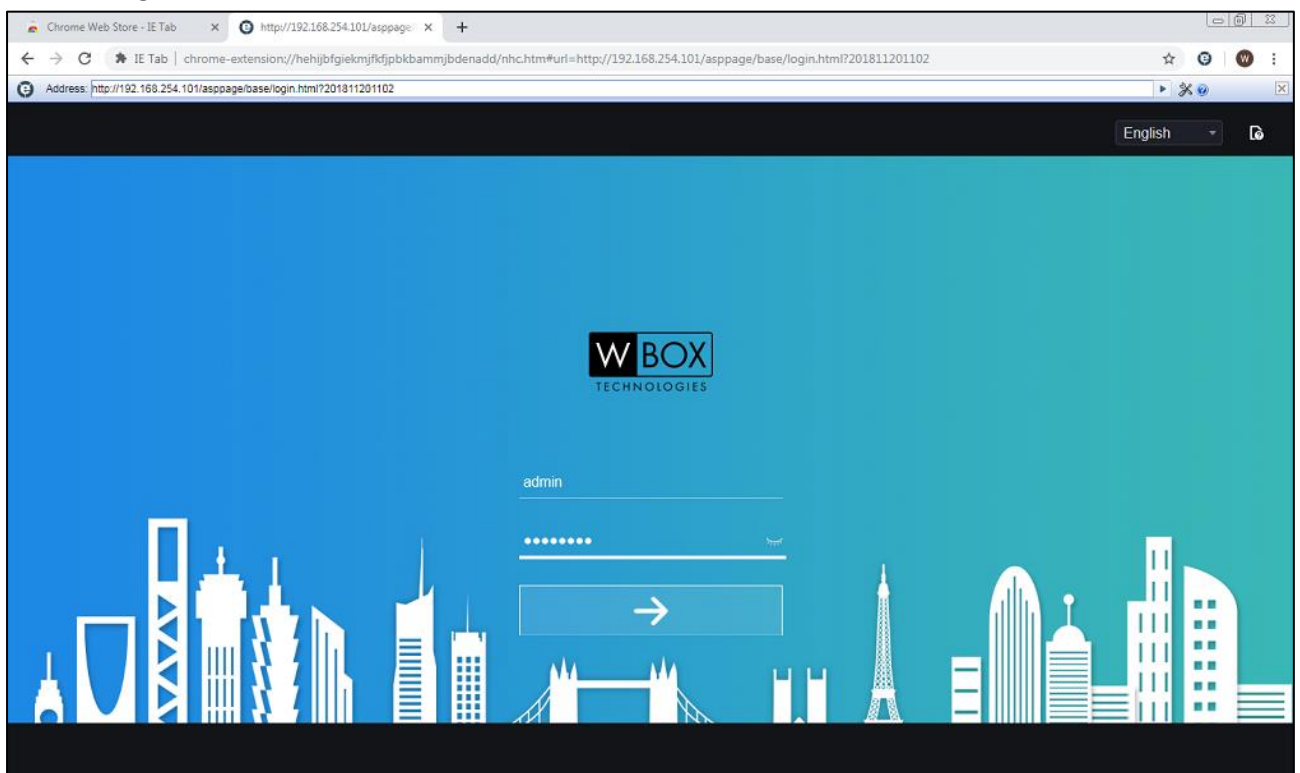
- This article is just around workaround on how to make the WBOX device accessible in Chrome or Firefox browser.
- We still highly recommend using Internet Explorer 10 or up to access the full functionality of web interface of the WBOX device.

Chrome

1. Access the device using Internet Explorer first to download and install the plugin.
2. After successfully installing the plugin on Internet Explorer, you may proceed to Chrome and follow the remaining steps below.
3. Go to this link to download the IE Tab extension for Chrome: <http://bit.ly/2PY3UJL>.
4. Follow the prompt in properly adding the IE Tab Extension to Chrome.
5. Once the IE Tab is successfully added to Chrome, you will see its icon on the upper right corner of the browser. Click the icon to display the page in an IE-based tab.

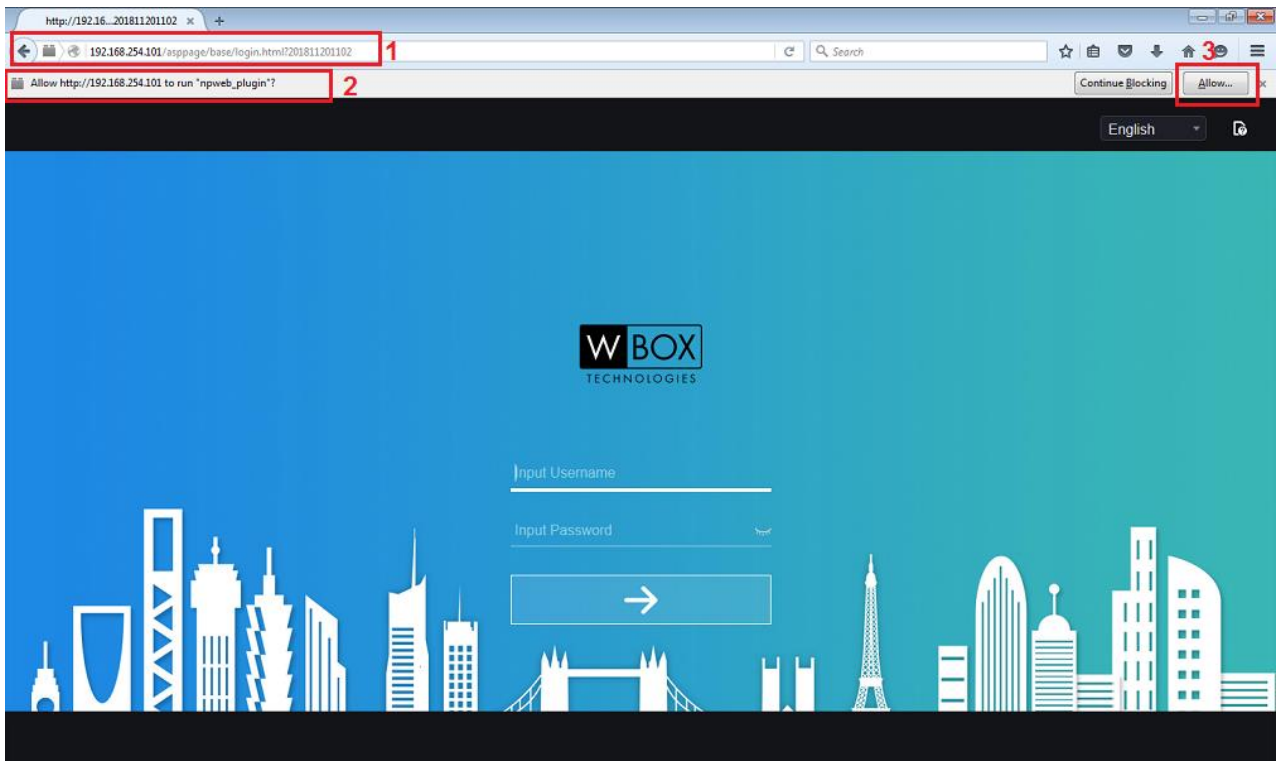


6. Enter the IP address of your WBOX device on the IE Tab's address bar. You may now log in to your WBOX device using Chrome.

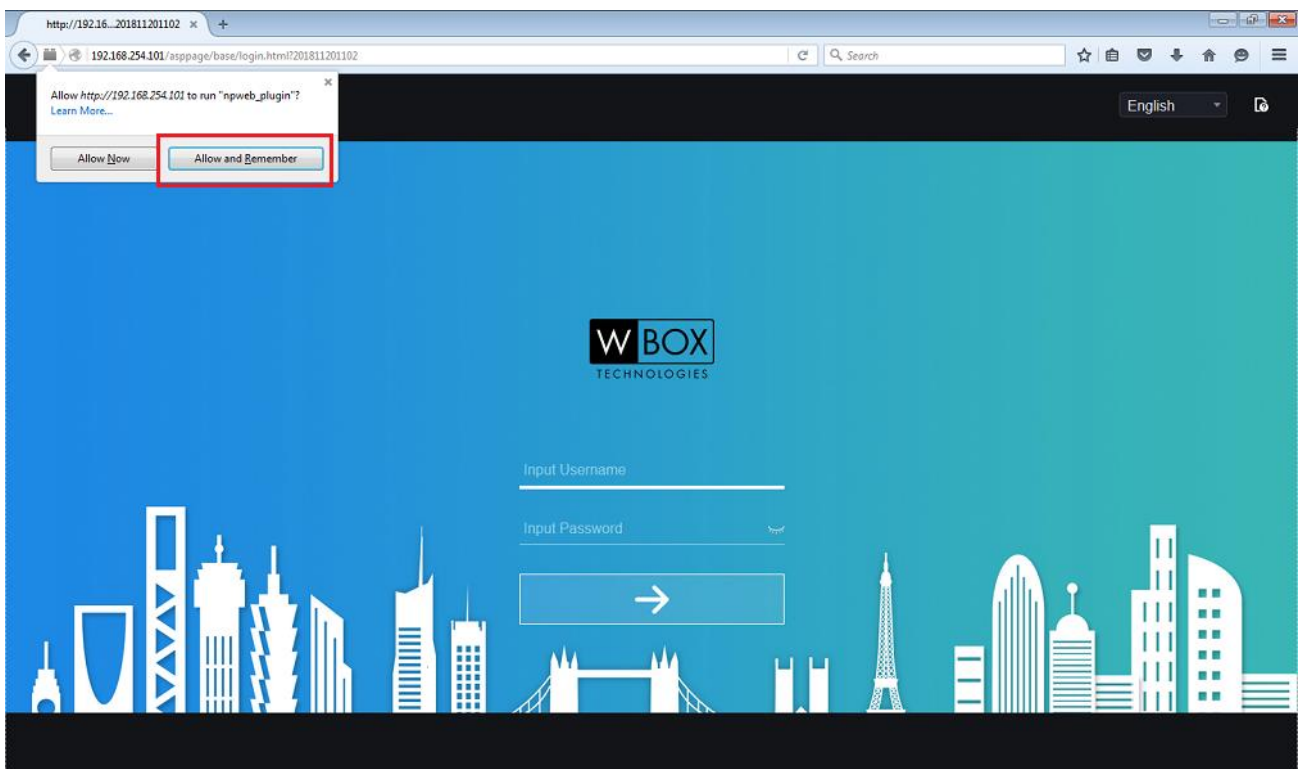


Firefox

1. Download an older version of Firefox. You can download it in here: <https://ftp.mozilla.org/pub/firefox/releases/44.0/win32/en-US/>
2. Enter the IP address of your WBOX device on the address bar in Firefox. You will be prompted with a message shown as below. Click **'Allow...'** to continue.



3. After clicking **'Allow...'**, you will be prompted with another message as shown below. Select **'Allow and Remember'**.



4. You may now log in to your WBOX device.
