

Home theater speaker placement recommendations. Use it as a guide to pick optimum locations for the speakers. Use the same basic guidelines if the television is corner mounted.



Room Dimensions:	Rear Surround Sound Speakers:
Width (wall that TV is centered on) Length Ceiling Height	In-Wall Wall Mount Bookshelf On-Wall
If the television is corner mounted, width will be the wall to the left of the television.	Other Mounted 2'-3' above ear level on the side or rear walls, ceiling mounted and just behind the listening area.

On-Wall Other Mounted right above or below the TV screen, as close to the same height of the Left & Right speakers as possible.	outlet. A passive in-wall or in-floor sub-woofer can be used if all speakers are flush mounted; this will require a separate amplifier.
