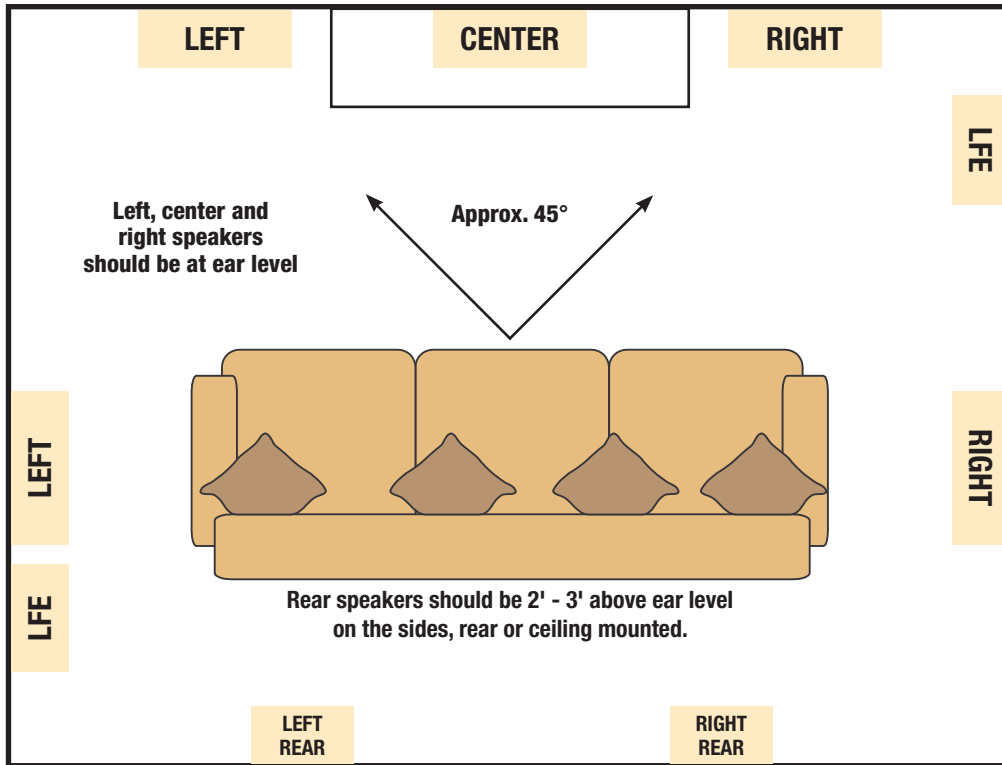

Home theater speaker placement recommendations. Use it as a guide to pick optimum locations for the speakers. Use the same basic guidelines if the television is corner mounted.



Room Dimensions:

Width (wall that TV is centered on)
 Length Ceiling Height
 If the television is corner mounted, width will be the wall to the left of the television.

Front Left & Right Speakers:

In-Wall Wall Mount
 Bookshelf On-Wall
 Other

Mounted equal distance from the center, approximately 45° apart, about ear level.

Center Speaker:

Shielded Cabinet In-Wall
 Shielded In-Wall Wall Mount
 On-Wall Other

Mounted right above or below the TV screen, as close to the same height of the Left & Right speakers as possible.

Rear Surround Sound Speakers:

In-Wall Wall Mount
 Bookshelf On-Wall
 Other

Mounted 2'-3' above ear level on the side or rear walls, ceiling mounted and just behind the listening area. Surround speakers should be matched in quality to the front speakers for future Dolby Digital requirements.

Sub-Woofer:

Stand alone powered sub
 Passive in-wall sub
 Passive in-floor sub
 Other

Two powered sub-woofers are recommended for optimum results. The units should be placed near an AC outlet. A passive in-wall or in-floor sub-woofer can be used if all speakers are flush mounted; this will require a separate amplifier.
