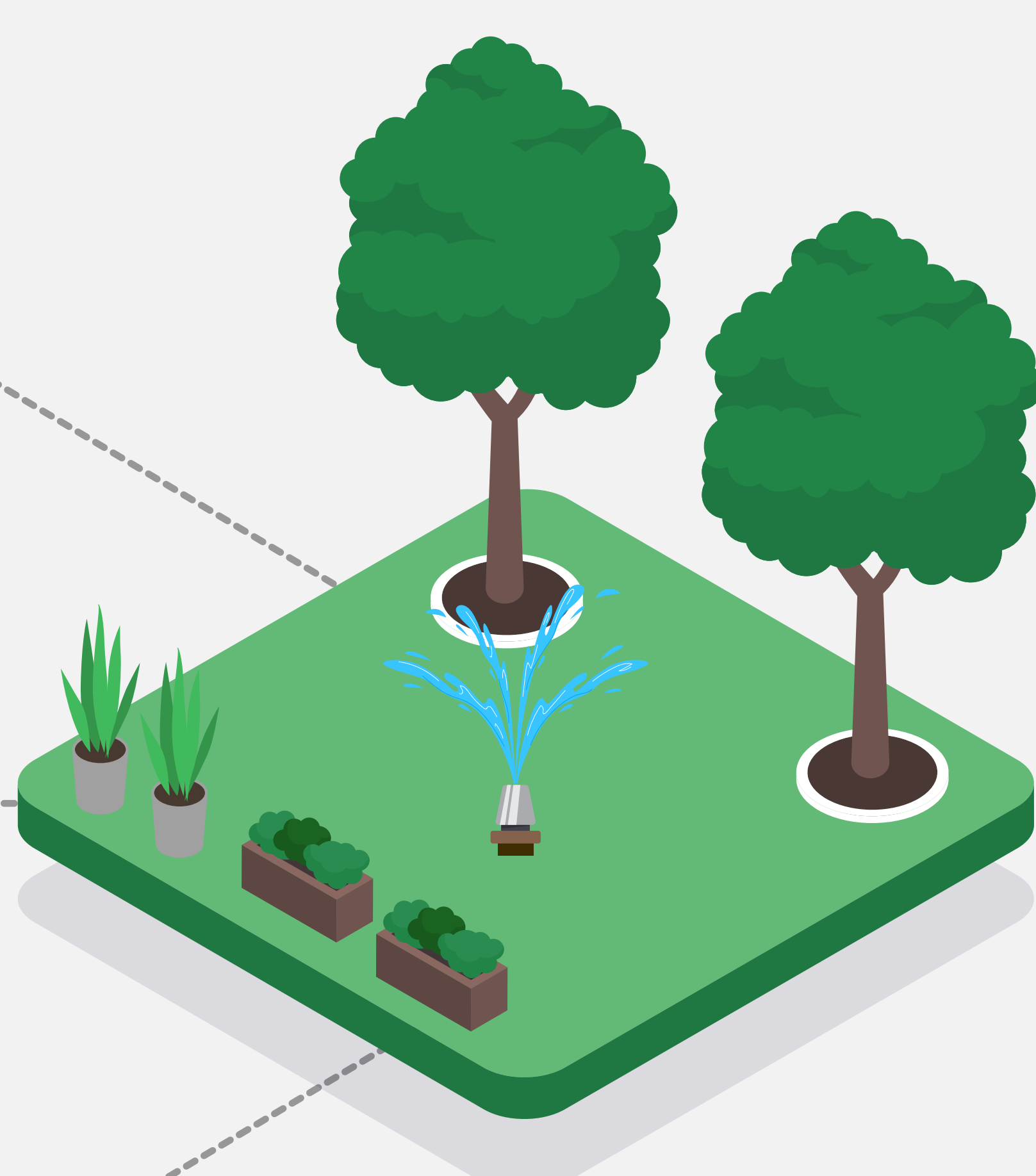


Integrate smart outlets and plugs

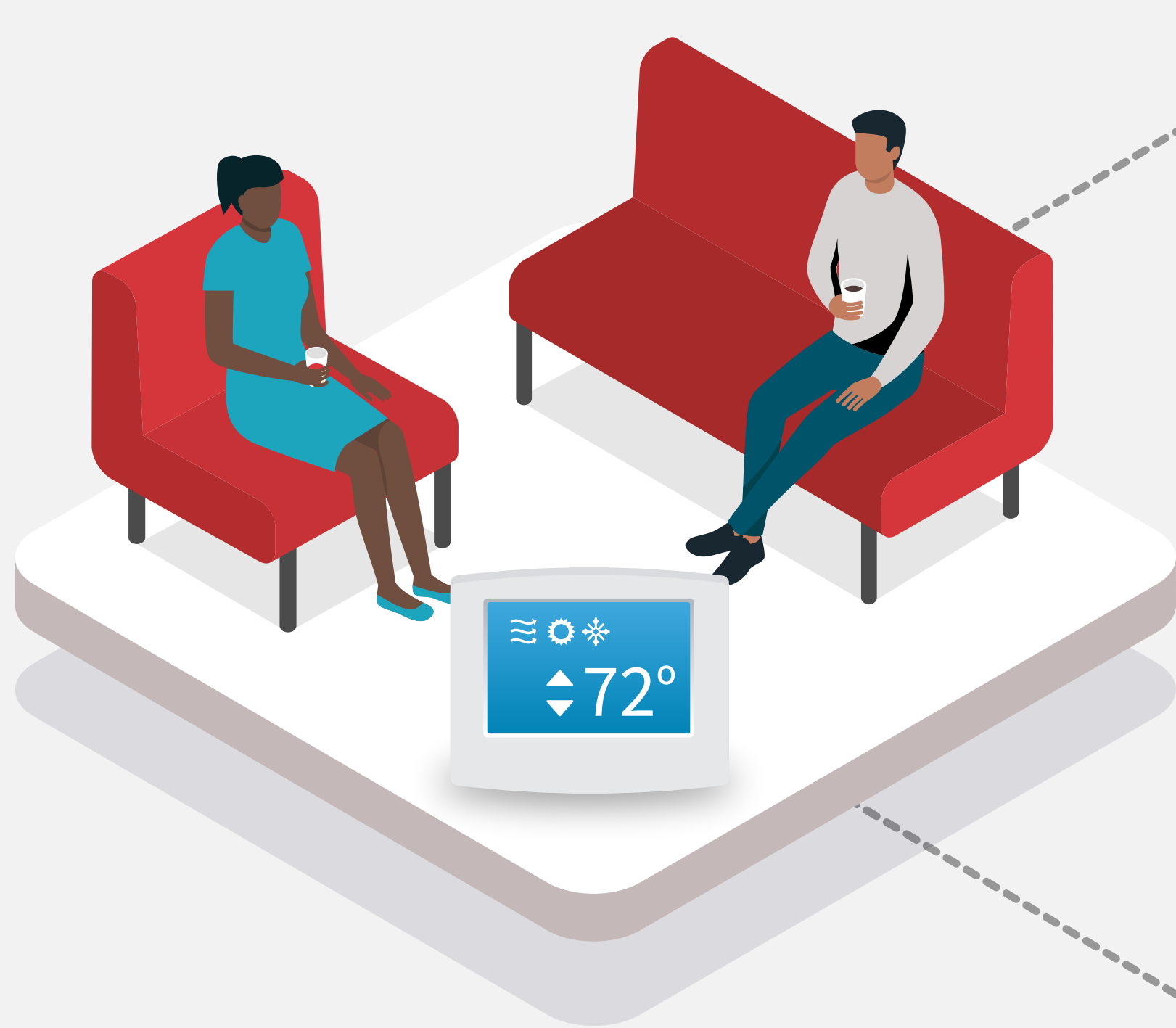
Suggest smart irrigation for smart water use
